

# Michigan CREP Process Overview



## Promotion

Who: Conservation District, FSA, NRCS, & Partners

What: Meetings, Fliers, Brochures, Mailings, & Farm Visits.



## Site Visit

Who: NRCS or TSP

What: Based on site visit, resource concern is identified & implementation of CP is feasible & needed. Existing cover is addressing the purpose of CP.



## File, Compiled, & Sign

Who: Participant & FSA

What: Participant accepts offer & signs CRP-1/CRP-2C.



## Conservation Plan Review

Who: NRCS

What: Conservation Plan & 1155 (*estimated cost share*) ready for review.



## Contract Approval

Who: FSA & MDARD

What: Contract approval. Participant may begin practice implementation, FSA issues SIP and MDARD issues enrollment/ re-enrollment bonus.



## Eligibility

Who: FSA

What: establishes, farm records, determines eligibility, initiates offer.



## Participant Notification

Who: FSA

What: Notice to Producer of accepted/ rejected/ modified offer.



## Conservation Planning Begins

Who: NRCS or TSP

What: Conservation Plan, supporting documents: 1155s, Maps, CPA-52, Job Sheets, etc.



## File, Compile, & Sign

Who: NRCS, FSA, and TSP

What: Producer signs Conservation Plan, & 1155. Assistance from CD for SIGMA.



## Practice Installation

Who: Participant

What: Submits receipts for C/S reimbursement & practice installation certification.

# Michigan CREP Incentives, Payments, & Practices

## Federal Incentives and Payments

- Soil Rental Rate (SRR) Payment base on 3 predominate soils
- 40% SRR Incentive
- Climate Smart Incentive – added to SRR
  - Grasses & Legumes = 5% (CP1)
  - Grass = 3% (CP2 & CP21)
  - Woody Biomass = 10% (CP5A & CP22)
  - Wetland (aquatic or emergent) = 3% (CP23 & CP23A)
- 50% cost-share for practice installation <sup>1/</sup>
- Signing Incentive Payment (SIP) based on 32.5% of first full year annual rental payment – applicable to new enrolled acres only <sup>1/</sup>
- Practice Incentive Payment (PIP) 10% <sup>1/</sup>
- 50% Cost-Share for Management Activities applicable only to CP22

## State Incentives and Payments

- 50% cost-share for practice installation <sup>1/</sup>
- New Enrollment Bonus
  - Enrollment Bonus \$150 p/ac CP5A, CP21, CP22, CP23/23A, & CP26
  - Water Quality Incentive Payment – applicable to land located in the Western Lake Erie Basin Watershed only <sup>1/</sup>
    - \$50/ac CP21, CP22, CP23/23A, & CP26
- Re-Enrollment Bonus
  - Re-enrollment Bonus
    - \$50 p/ac CP1 & CP2
    - \$150 p/ac CP5A, CP21, CP22, CP23/23A, & CP26
- Maintenance & Management Payment
  - \$100 p/ac CP1, CP2, CP5A, CP21, CP22, & CP23/23A
  - \$500 p/ac CP26

## CREP Practices

- CP1, Establishment of Permanent Introduced Grasses and Legumes
- CP2, Establishment of Permanent Native Grass
- CP5A, Field Windbreak
- CP21, Filter Strips
- CP22, Riparian Buffer
- CP23/23A, Wetland Restorations
- CP26, Sediment Control Structure
