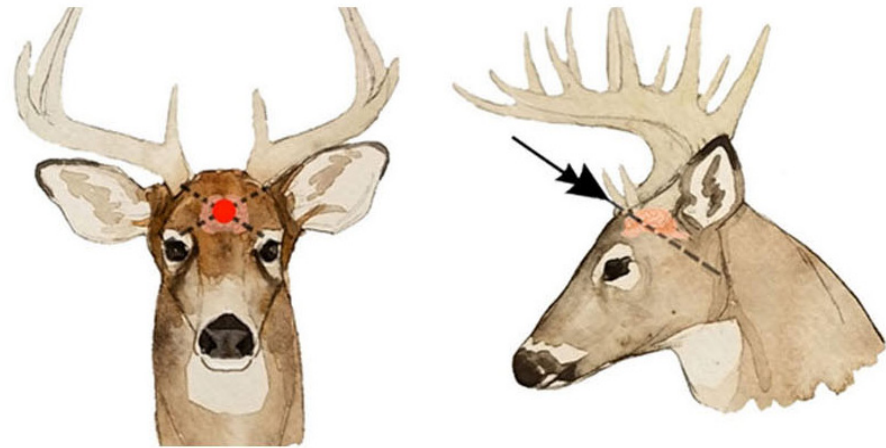
THE RED SPOT IS THE TARGET.

GUNSHOT:

Rifle: 22-caliber rifle: Round nose shell is preferred.

Shotguns: 410, 16, or 20 gauges loaded with 3-inch shells: Slugs are preferred.

Firearm standoff distance must be **at least 3** inches from the skull plate.



Confirmation of insensibility within 30 seconds:

1. Lack of corneal reflex
2. Inability to right itself or floppy head
3. Lack of pain response

Confirmation of death within 3 minutes:

1. Lack of corneal reflex
2. Lack of respiration
3. Lack of heartbeat
4. Lack of vocalization

If animal is not rendered insensible, use a second shot with a firearm or captive bolt gun.
