What is 4-H?

4-H is delivered by Cooperative Extension—a community of more than 100 public universities across the nation that provides experiences where young people learn by doing. Kids complete hands-on projects in areas like health, science, agriculture and citizenship, in a positive environment where they receive guidance from adult volunteers and are encouraged to take on proactive leadership roles. Kids experience 4-H in every county in the country—through in-school and after-school programs, school and community clubs and 4-H camps.

In 4-H, we believe in the power of young people. We see that every child has valuable strengths and real influence to improve the world around us. We are America's largest youth development organization—empowering nearly six million young people across the U.S. with the skills to lead for a lifetime. 4-H is also Michigan's largest youth organization with over 200,000 members. Eaton County 4-H has approximately 700 youth, 190 volunteers, and 28 clubs.

Interested in joining 4-H?

- When do I sign up? Enrollment begins September 1 and ends August 31, deadlines depend on what experience you are joining. Youth who wish to show at the Eaton County Fair as a 4-H member must be enrolled by March 15.
- What ages can join? Youth with a 4-H age of 5—19 can join! 4-H ages are determined by their age on January 1. 4-H ages 5—7 are Cloverbuds and participate in non-competitive programming. You do not need to own an animal or live on a farm to join 4-H! We have many clubs that focus on non-animal projects, such as archery, shooting sports, crafts, wildlife biology, and more.
- <u>Is there a cost?</u> There is no cost to join 4-H in general. Some clubs and experiences may charge a club due or other fees and you may need to purchase supplies for projects depending on the group.
- <u>Can adults join?</u> Adult volunteers can also join 4-H to give back and lend a hand! Our screened volunteers are a critical part of the success of 4-H—make a difference with positive youth development in our county by sharing your skills! Contact the Eaton County MSU Extension office for more information on how to volunteer.

How do I join?

Find a club or 4-H experience (camp, workshop, etc.) and contact the volunteer or the Extension office! Inside this brochure are clubs that meet on a long term, year-round basis. Short term SPIN clubs (8 weeks or less with topics like robotics, wildlife, financial literacy, engineering, etc.), 4-H camps, and other events can be found on our website on our 4-H Calendar and on our Facebook page as availability varies throughout the year. Find a club that meets your interests and contact the person listed to find out more information about that club. Once you have selected a club, the administrative leader for the club will help you sign up!
