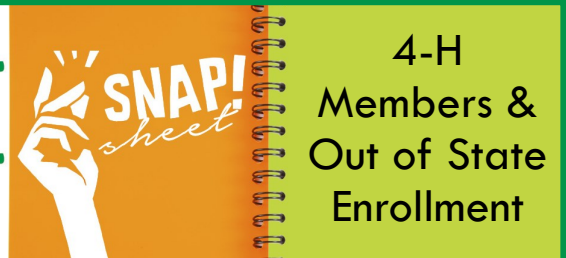
Virtual National 4-H Shooting Sports Quiz Bowl

Save the dates: June 22 through 26, 2020.

This is a state, regional, and national event for individuals and team play.

Quiz Bowl Guidelines:

1. One quiz will be available for each age division, through *Kahoot*, starting June 22 at 12:00 AM PT. The tests will close at 12:00 AM PT, June 27.
2. The quiz will incorporate subject matter from all disciplines and include content on 4-H, 4-H Shooting sports, positive youth development, and risk management.
3. The junior quiz will consist of 30 questions. The intermediate/senior quiz will consist of 50 questions. Questions range from multiple choice, true/false, fill in the blank, and identification.
4. Resource materials and registration instructions will be available on the National 4-H Shooting Sports web page.
5. Individuals and teams will be divided into two age divisions for the 2019-2020 4-H year. Juniors are less than 14 years of age based on state enrollment dates (no Cloverbuds). Intermediates/seniors are 14 to 19 years of age based on state enrollment dates. Teams must be formed prior to beginning the Quiz Bowl.
6. Teams will consist of 3 to 4 members. Because the quizzes are comprehensive (covering archery, hunting skills, muzzle loading, pistol, rifle, shotgun, and western heritage), teams should be made up of individuals with knowledge of one or more of these disciplines. Teams do not need to be made up of individuals from the same club or county.
7. Points are awarded based on correct answers, the time taken to answer questions, and answer streak. Raw scores will be used to identify individual winners. Team members compete as individuals. The sum of the top three raw scores per team will be used to determine team placement. (i.e. the lowest score on a four member team will be dropped). States will be notified of individual and team ranking from first to last. It will be up to each state to determine appropriate recognition.
8. State individual and team scores will then be compared regionally (North Central, North East, Southern, and Western). States and regions will be notified of individual and team ranking from first to last. The top individual will receive a rosette and 1st place ribbon. Individuals finishing 2nd through 10th will receive placement ribbons. The top team will receive rosettes and 1st place ribbons. Teams finishing 2nd through 10th will receive placement ribbons.
9. Regional scores will then be compared and ranked from first to last to determine the winning national individual and team. The top individual will receive a medallion, rosette and 1st place ribbon. Individuals finishing 2nd through 10th will receive placement ribbons. The top team will receive medallions, rosettes and 1st place ribbons. Teams finishing 2nd through 10th will receive placement ribbons.



SETTING UP A PROFILE

You will be required to set up a family profile on 4HOnline, the on-line Alabama 4-H Enrollment and event registration program. The family profile will be where the members will enroll. The website can be found at <https://al.4honline.com>.

1 You will need to create a profile. Select *I need to setup a profile*, complete the fields required, and click *Create Login*. For Out-of-State residents, select **State Office** as your County on this screen.

2 Follow the instructions on the Family Information page and click *continue*.
SET UP ONLY ONE FAMILY PROFILE PER HOUSEHOLD!

After adding the family, add your family members to that family profile. **IMPORTANT! Only adult records should belong to 4-H Adult volunteers.** Use the follow to determine the type of membership to add:

- **Adult:** 4-H adult volunteers who have been background checked and screened at the local level.
- **Contact:** Adults who are NOT volunteers and youth under the age of 8. Use this option when registering family members for an event.
- **Youth:** 4-H youth between the ages of 8 and 19.

NOTE: If you are an out-of-state youth, select Youth and click the Add Short Term Member button.

3 For adults and youth, the next pages are Authorization Releases and Health Forms for risk management. These are important to have completed in case you get injured during a 4-H event. Your registration will not be accepted unless all authorizations and health information fields are complete. Click *Submit Enrollment* to send in your enrollment.

You are now ready to register for an event. Follow the tip sheet for that event for registration details.

Registration for the National 4-H Shooting Sports QuizBowl is run through the 4HOnline system. You must set up a 4HOnline Family Profile and add each youth to your family before the registration process can begin. Depending on your member status and state of residency, you will fall under one of the following 2 categories:

- **4-H Member from Alabama:** If you are a 4-H member and a resident of Alabama, sign onto your family profile and register following steps 1-7 below. If you do not have a Family Profile already set up, you may contact your [Local County Extension Office](#). Once enrolled, complete steps 1-7 below to register.
- **Non-Alabama Resident:** If you are not a resident of Alabama, view the tip-sheet “How to Enroll in 4HOnline– Non-Alabama Residence” for instructions on enrolling, then complete steps 1-7 below to register.

TO REGISTER

1. Log onto your family profile and scroll to the bottom of the Member List Page to register for the event.
2. Select the appropriate member and event you are registering by selecting the drop down arrows.
3. Download the files listed for event specific information and print them off for references to important rules and resources.
4. Click the *Register* beside the Registration Type to start the process.
5. Complete the Entry section. Any bolded questions are required to continue. Click *Continue* when done.
6. A Cart Summary will appear showing amount owed. This event is free. Click *Check Out*.
7. If information is correct on the Confirm screen, click *Confirm Order*.
8. The last page will give you a summary / confirmation of your registration order and allow another chance to download the additional information files.
9. Your registration must be approved at the state level before you are officially registered. You will get an email telling you the registration was received and another when it is approved. The email will be sent to your family profile email you set up.
