BEFORE SHOW DAY

HORSE/PONY

- _____ Check for feet or shoe problems.
- _____ Pull mane, if needed (ask for help).
- _____ Brush your horse every day.
- _____ Bath your horse (have an adult help you).
- _____ May need to clip bridle path (ask your 4-H leader).
- _____ Keep the stall EXTRA clean.

TACK/EQUIPMENT

- _____ Check buckles, snaps, etc. . . Fix, if needed.
- _____ Clean your tack.
- _____ Organize grooming supplies to take with you (mud brushes, hoof pick, sprays, etc. . .)
- _____ Pack as much as you can the night before, (don't forget a water bucket and hay).

Y O U

- _____ Collect the necessary clothes and accessories for the classes you will be in far in advance (English and/or Western).
- _____ Pack safety pins for your back tag.
- _____ GET A GOOD NIGHT'S SLEEP BEFORE THE SHOW.

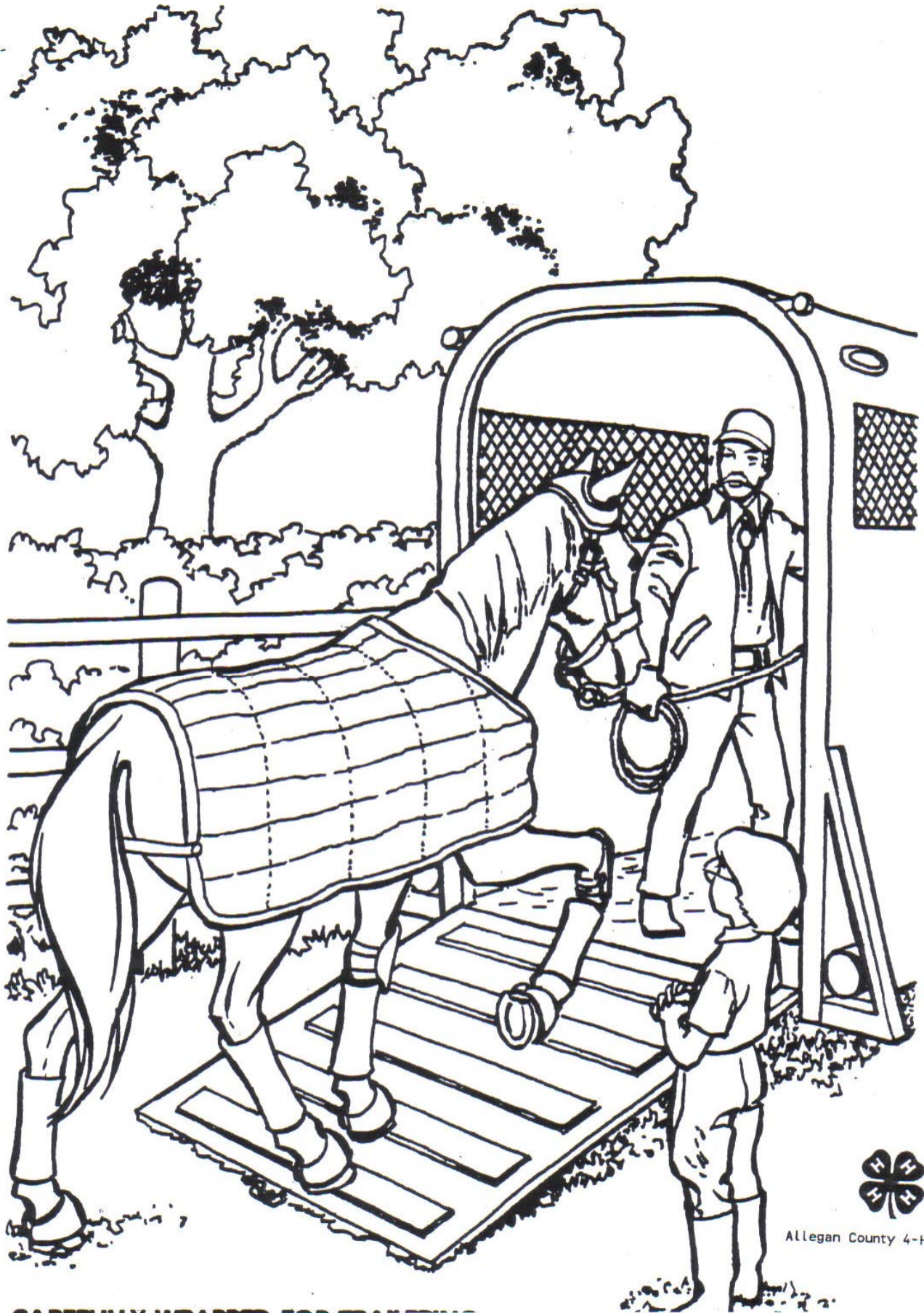
SHOW DAY !!!

- _____ Plan to get up early.
- _____ Do an extra good job grooming your horse
- _____ Prepare your horse for trailering (ask an adult to load your horse into the trailer and unload your horse at the show).

AT THE SHOW:

- _____ Check in at the Entry Booth for your back number.
- _____ You are responsible for knowing what classes you are in and for being on time for your class. Stay close to the show ring so you can hear when your class is called.
- _____ Walk your horse around before going in the ring to get him warmed up.
- _____ REMEMBER TO HAVE FUN AND SHOW GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP.



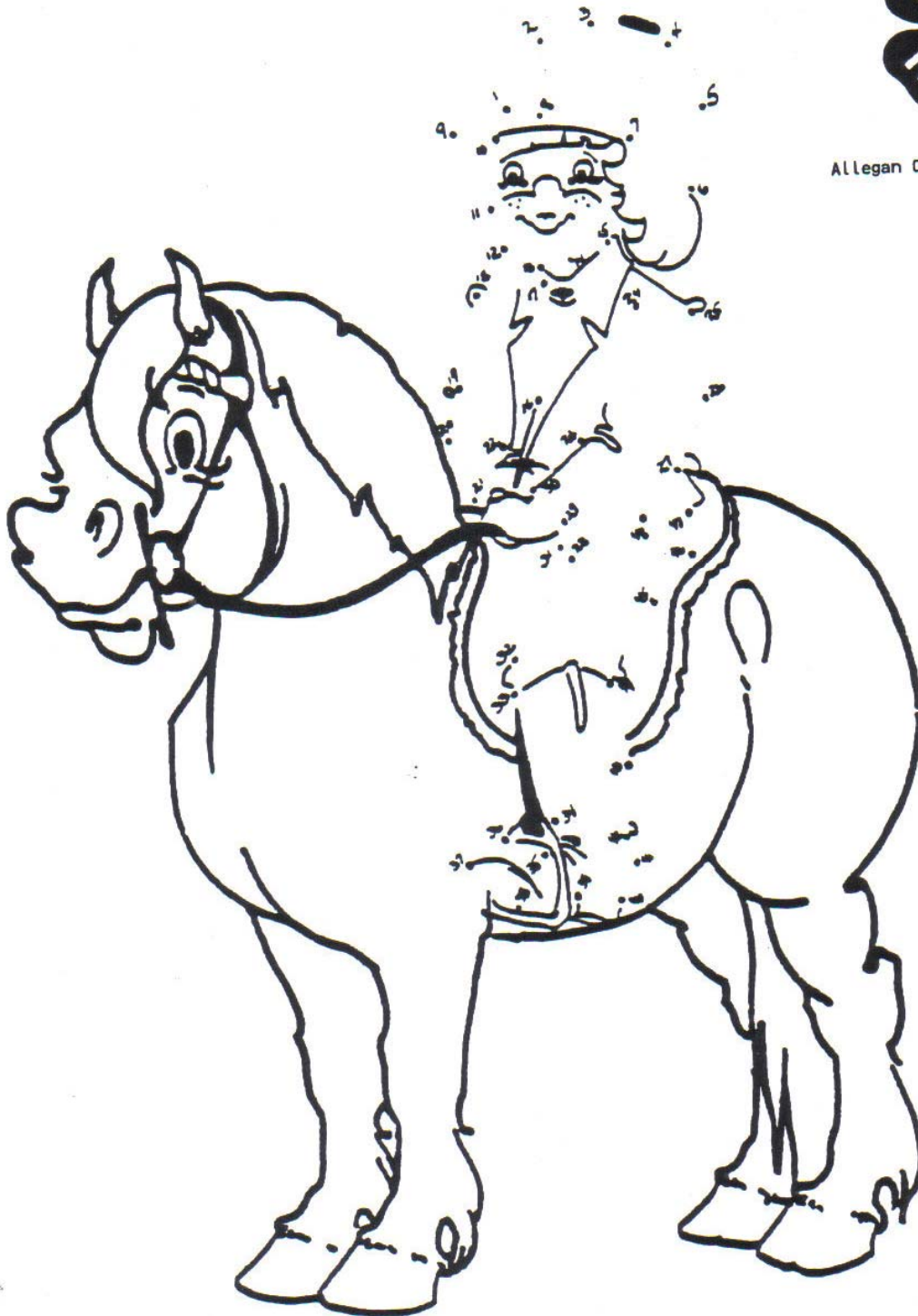

WESTERN CLOTHING

- _____ Western hat (or SEI certified helmet)
- _____ Western boots
- _____ Long-sleeved western shirt and long pants (if pants have beltloops, a belt must be worn).
- _____ A tie, pin, choker, or scarf is required.

WESTERN EQUIPMENT

- _____ Western bit, bridle and saddle should fit the horse and rider.

ENGLISH CLOTHING

- _____ Jackets in conservative colors such as: black, blue, beige, gray, green or brown.
- _____ Kentucky jodhpurs that match or look well with jacket.
- _____ Matching tie.
- _____ A derby (or SEI certified helmet)
- _____ Jodhpur boots

ENGLISH EQUIPMENT

- _____ English-type saddle or dressage saddle.
- _____ Full bridles or pelhams.
